

Personal Pronouns (Part 2)

1. Possessive Adjectives:

The **Possessive Adjectives** are words that have the function of modifying a noun indicating ownership or possession. For example, "This is **her** book" the possessive adjective **"her"** is specifying that the book belongs to **a woman**.

| Persons | Subject Pronouns | Possessive Adjectives | Translation |

Ex.:

Sheila is **my** cousin. She lives near **my** house.

3. Possessive Pronouns:

Possessive Pronouns indicate ownership and are used to replace the noun contained in the sentence.

| Persons | Possessive Pronouns | Translation |

| 2 nd . Person Singular | Yours | |
| 3 rd . Person Singular | His | |
| 3 rd . Person Singular | Hers | |

| 2 nd . Person Plural | Yours | |
| 3 rd . Person Plural | Theirs | |

Ex.:

These books are hers. (Not: These books are her books.)
