# ➤ Inductive Grammar: Present Perfect (Special Words):



Look at these examples of the present perfect with **already**, **yet**, **ever**, and **before**.

Have you toured Quito **yet**?

I've **already** tried sushi.

Have you **ever** eaten Indian food?

Has she **ever** been to London?

Has she **already** tried Korean barbecue?

I haven't tried sashimi **yet**.

Have you eaten Thai food **before**?

Has she been to Paris **before**?

I've **already** tried Indian food three times, but I've **never** tried Thai food.  
I've tried Indian food **before**, but I **haven't ever** tried Thai food.
