Ways to ask about time:

What time is it?

Excuse me, could you tell me what time it is, please?

Excuse me, could you tell me the time, please?

Ways to ask if somebody has free time or not:

Do you have the time?

Have you got the time?



➤ Reading the Time:

How to Say the Time:

What time is it?

1:00 – *It's one o'clock.*

1:05 – *It's one-oh-five. / It's five past (after) one.*

1:10 – *It's one ten. / It's ten past (after) one.*

1:15 – *It's one fifteen. / It's a quarter past (after) one.*

1:30 – *It's one thirty. / It's half past (after) one.*

1:45 – *It's one forty-five. / It's a quarter to two.*

1:50 – *It's one fifty. / It's ten to two.*

1:55 – *It's one fifty-five. / It's five to two.*
