## Possessive Adjectives

### Watch out!

**Possessive Adjectives show that something belongs to a person.**

*His name is Carl.*

*NOT He name is Carl.*

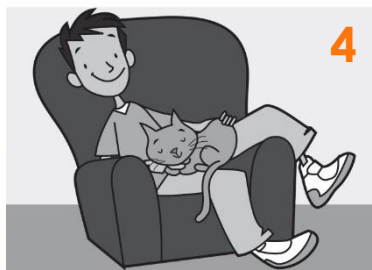
